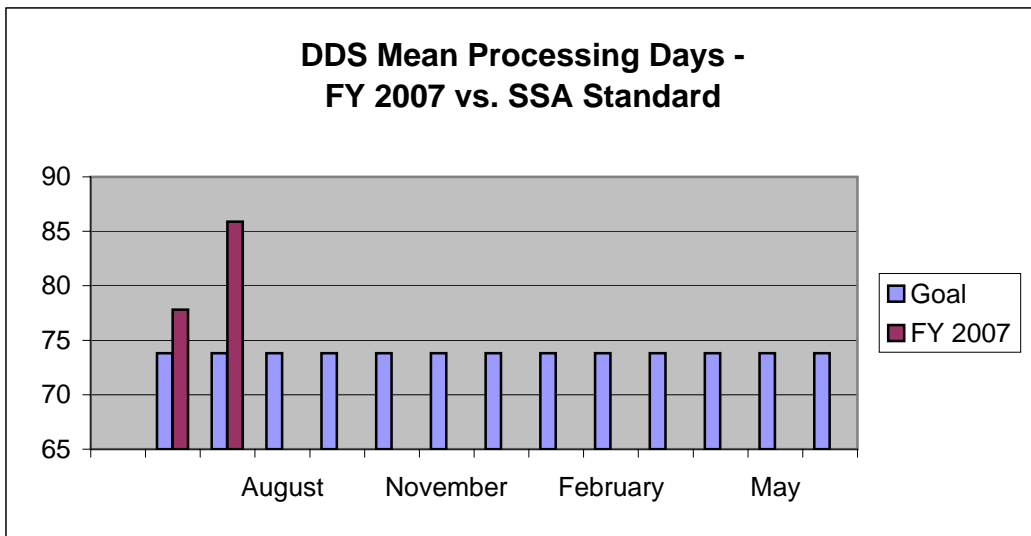
Objective #1: To provide timely disability decisions for Title II, Title XVI and Title XIX disability claims.
